IMPORTANT COURSE REQUIREMENTS

ISPC Home Study: Coaches wanting to begin their training in the ISPC (formerly Level 2 program) will need to complete and pass the Home Study prior to attending the Sport Science/ Stroking & Skating Skills course. Cost of Homestudy includes marking fee and shipping and handling. It is recommended that the coach has completed NCCP Theory Introduction to Competition Part B

ISPC Technical Courses: ** to receive credit of ISPC Phase 2 coaches will be required to complete **ALL 5 Technical courses and workbooks.** Sport Science/ Stroking & Skating Skills (2 days) must be completed before taking Singles (1 day), Ice Dancing (1 day), Pair Skating and Synchronized Skating (1 day).

ISPC Phase 3 Practical: Once a Coach has achieved Phases 1 and 2, they will complete the practical requirements listed for the discipline they wish to certify in. Because Coaches at this phase will have received training in all disciplines, certifying in all disciplines is the expectation of Skate Canada.
